

Notice of Intent to Award a Public Contract of the Sterling Hill Community Development District

The Board of Supervisors (the “**Board**”) of the Sterling Hill Community Development District (the “**District**”) held a publicly noticed meeting and reviewed the sole letter it received from a prospective vendor, Whitaker Contracting Corp., who provided information regarding their ability to supply the contractual services for the maintenance of certain roadways of the District in response to the District’s notice for contractual services. The purpose of this notice is to inform the public, based on the Board’s evaluation, the Board voted to approve Resolution 2018-01, and made a determination of a single source contractor, authorized the piggybacking of a public contract, awarded a contract to Whitaker Contracting Corp., and authorized the execution of the contract on behalf of the District.

In accordance with the District’s notice and the District’s Rules of Procedures, please note that any person adversely affected by this notice must file a written notice of protest with the District Manager (CFischer@rizzetta.com) within seventy-two (72) hours (excluding Saturdays, Sundays and state holidays) after the posting of this notice, and then within seven (7) calendar days (inclusive of Saturdays, Sundays and state holidays) of the date on the written notice of protest must file a formal written protest stating with particularity the facts and law upon which such protest is based. Failure to do so shall constitute a waiver of proceedings under Chapter 190, *Florida Statutes*, and the District’s Rules of Procedure.
