Swimming Pool Policies & Procedures

1. The swimming pool facilities are open from 10:00am to dusk (dusk time is set by staff's discretion).
2. You must have a swipe card to gain access to the pool, you are allowed 2 per home address. Must show proper paperwork and ID.
3. Each household may bring up to five guests for use of the pool facilities but must accompany their guests at all times.
4. No Lifeguard on Duty! Persons using the pool and other Swim Club facilities do so at their own risk.
5. Children under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult 18 years of age or older at all times while using the pool facilities.
6. Infants and toddlers who are still in diapers MUST wear an approved swim diaper or rubber swim pants. Diapers are not permitted in the pool.
7. All persons using the pool facilities shall obey the capacity requirements as defined by Hernando County.
8. Proper swimming attire must be worn while using the pool facilities. (Bathing suits only, no cut-off shorts)
9. Showering is mandatory before use of the pool facilities.
10. No running is allowed in the pool facilities.
11. No diving is allowed.
12. Flotation devices are allowed in the pool; however they must not interfere with the enjoyment of other guests using the pool.
13. No rough housing or chicken fighting is allowed in the swimming pool.
14. No balls allowed, and toys should not be thrown within the pool or pool area.
15. No smoking.
16. No animals are allowed in the pool facilities.
17. No food or drink are allowed within 6 feet of the pool.
18. No alcoholic beverages are allowed in the pool facilities.
19. No glass containers are allowed in the pool area.
20. Radios are prohibited; other than headphones.
21. Pool furniture shall not be removed from the pool deck area or placed into the swimming pool.
22. Belongings left in the pool facilities after dusk shall be placed in the clubhouse's "Lost & Found" for a period of one week. If the item(s) are not claimed, they will be discarded.
23. Call 911 in the event of an emergency.
